Redistricting is to be voted on at Area Committee Meeting in Greensboro on Februrary 24-25. Sam gave some background information:

The last redistricting for Area 51 occurred in 1979. One aim in the redistricting efforts is to assist financially troubled districts by combining them with financially healthy districts. For the counties in our current district, proposal would have Allamance, Caswell, Rockingham counties, along with the northern part of Guilford county comprise **District 36**. Orange and Chatham counties would form District 33 under this plan. Rick stated that the new District 36 would have a harder time going forward than the new District 33, citing as an example the advantage of keeping the district contact information (such as the PO Box) that the new District 33 would have over District 36.

Two years ago, excess budgeted funds unspent, but not shifted to other district spending areas, instead sent up to Area and GSO. Disbursements are done now in January. That way, we start the year with money, and contributions from January allow us to start February with money. Bill says we may need to be prepared for ever-increasing costs for website and computer issues.
